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- Persisted to identify the challenges and opportunities available for bright students and to list the activities for the preparation
- Undergraduate Programmes i.e. Computer Applications (BCA) and Management (BBA) have been brought under the umbrella of AICTE to ensure coordinated development in technical and management education to take up the postgraduate study like MCA and MBA in near future
- Final year students are instigated to ensure the details of Skills acquired and Internship details in Resume
- Medical Physics department need to conduct more coaching classes for their students
- Chemistry department students required more Industry exposure in connection with that insisted to sign many MoUs with Industries
- Mathematics department need to solicit their students in building up Computer skills along with Mathematics knowledge in an interesting and simple ways

- Advised to create collaboration with KMCH Group of institutions and make collaborators frequent visits to teach courses for students to leverage the strengths of their Skill development (This component need to be highlighted in HoDs Academic Council presentation)
- Food Science and Nutrition department to bring Visiting faculty and to take Projects and Internship with Poultry Farm Production
- All the departments are insisted to carry out activities and do





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
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contribution under Entrepreneur Development Cell and to include these schedule in College Academic Calendar

- Faculty of Computer Science is advised to include more practical and to encourage the knowledge of coding and programming among the student fraternity
- Faculty of Commerce students are advised to undergo Internship in RBI, Skill Development Corporation of India, Marketing Research services and Digital Marketing Industries. In addition, need to complete Typing Course as mandatory in the very First semester

GC nominee, Mr. A. M. Palaniswamy, Director, Aero Space advocated the following:

- Insisted all the faculty fraternity to understand the Vision and Mission of the college and the totality of a student to mould and shape the students where their personal life, family and society will be benefited and uplifted when they become graduates
- Faculty of Commerce fraternity to send the students for training in Bank, Chartered Accountant Office and Insurance where they could unearth their talents and opportunities available
- It is insisted to increase the strength of student aspirants up to 250 in Chartered Accountant coaching class
- Faculty of Computer Science is advised to highlight the activities carried out under Skill Development and Entreprenuer Development Cell in AC Presentation
- Further, suggested to start Student Teacher Programme where the students will work as a teacher for the substandard level students to get familiar with peer teaching and to gain in depth knowledge





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
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about the content and could also provide monetary benefits for them

- Students of Science and Mathematics stream could take up their higher studies and career in German Academy and Institutions
- Banking & Insurance students shall be urged to take up a study on Non Performing Assets (NPAs) and to be qualified as Bankruptcy Auditor
- Foreign language, German shall be promoted under Center for Language Learning in the college
- Could establish Electronic Mobility sector in the college
- Physics department shall introduce the topics like Super capacitor and Battery charges module, Finite element analysis in the curriculum.
- It is also insisted to establish NABL Accreditation for the student and the faculty calibration to receive more funds or grants and to crate lot of job opportunities. Testing lab and Calibration must be introduced in all the department





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- KMCH with Hospital needs Calibration. Calibration department have to be established in the college
- Catering Science and Hotel Management should introduce topics on designs for Canteen, Pantry and Cooking area and Cooking Capacity and Vessels Management in the curriculum
- Biotechnology department should go for extending career opportunities for Bioinformatics and should integrate Life Sciences in the curriculum
- Food Science and Nutrition department should apply for State and Central government grants for Millet recipes
- Computer Technology department to include RPT Engineering terms like Web application development and designing tools in their curriculum
- Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning department instructed to frame curriculum to meet the needs of Industry 4.0 i.e.
 Dashboards of Health on Machines to be included along with the concern of Bharathiar University Nominee
- Commerce with CA department need to include Robotics Process Automation (RPA) 2.0 and Artificial Intelligence tools in Accounting and Taxation in the course, syllabus and curriculum in gradual manner
- Commerce with BPS department insisted to add e- Commerce IoT
- Commerce with IB department to introduce Export Subsidies, RoDTEP, applications of AI Logistics and Green Supply Chain Management, Warehouse Logistics Management and Hub and Spoke model in the syllabus and to sign MoU with Freight





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
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industries along with to send the students for internship in Small Scale Industries at Patel Road, Coimbatore

- MHA department to introduce House Keeping in Non-Clinical operations, Dignity of work in House Keeping services and Sanitation centers, Equipment in Cleaning and to train the students in Utilities in Hospital Management and Clean Apparatuses needs, uses, purposes and cost in the curriculum for the students
- Chemistry department to include Electric Mobility, Polymer technology, Rubber, Plastics, Synthetic Textiles, Technical textiles, and Defense mechanism in the curriculum
- Placement directors and faculty need to train the students by signing MoUs with the local institutes for more placements in Entry level managers and executive jobs under management appointments

Dr. N. Ponpandian, VC Nominee suggested the following:

- Suggested to include more Experimental exercises (75% Practical and 25% Theory) and to introduce lot of new courses in Value added and Certificate programmes to strengthen the knowledge of new things based on Industry 4.0
- Training on new things and innovations to be established and the experience of the faculty is also mandatory
- New advancements and trends to be bettered lot in the syllabi of Basic Sciences
- Research knowledge of the students need to be enhanced and Research as a component must be added in all PG Programmes
- Students should be involved and encouraged in Research project proposals writing and to send for Internship to Indian Academy of
