In Semester I- Core II: British Literature- II paper the poem Ode on the Grecian Urn by John Keats has been removed from Unit I. In Semester II- Core V: British Literature- III paper, the essay The English Character by George Orwell has been removed due to unavailability of the text.
- 2. The following items are resolved to remove and replaced by the approval of the Board. In Semester I- Core III: American Literature paper, the Criticism Empson's Seven Types of Ambiguity has been replaced to T.S. Eliot's Tradition and Individual Talents in Unit-V. In Semester II- Core VI: Indian Writing in English paper, the poem Night of the Scorpion by Nissim Ezekiel and A River by A.K. Ramanujam have been removed from Unit I due to repetition, instead Looking for a Cousin on a Swing by A.K. Ramanujam was replaced in this paper. In Semester II- Core VIII: Commonwealth Literature the poem Christmas Carol by Sangster has been replaced with Mansfield's The Man with the Wooden Leg due to the

unavailability of the text. In Semester III- Core XI: World Classics in Translation paper, Unit-V has been replaced from Bassnett's Translation Studies to Kalidasa's Shakunthala.

- 3. The recommendations are resolved to include and approve by the Board in the following subjects. In Semester II- Core IX: Research Methodology paper, Unit I has been replaced as Background Knowledge of Research and Unit II as Fundamentals of Research. The textbook Sinha, Research Methods in English. 2007. Atlantic Publications. New Delhi has been included as one of the prescribed textbooks for the same paper.
