## SECTION B

### 1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution

The College Emblem signifies a ‘**book**’, a ‘**glowing lamp**’ and a ‘**rising sun**’ each representing **Quality Education, Enlightening Students’ Knowledge** and the **Prosperity attained** respectively. To provide Quality Education to all the students and to help them to attain prosperity, the college conducts **Value-added programmes** (through external agencies), **Seminars, Guest Lectures, Conferences, Placement Training Programmes**, and several need-based courses.

The **Library** of the college is kept open from **8 a.m. to 8 p.m.** on all working days, reinstating the dictum proclaimed in the emblem, “**KATRANAITHU OORUM ARIVU**”, which can be roughly translated as “Knowledge is like water: it surges (in abundance) as one goes deeper.”

The objective of the college is to provide quality education, training and research facilities to the students of our nation. This year, **44** students have enrolled themselves for their **M.Phil. Programme** and **6** have enrolled themselves for their **PhD Programme**. It fulfills the vision of the college by offering research programmes.

The college also aims at inculcating ethical, moral and social values in the minds of the educators and the students and **motivating and nurturing co-operation, tolerance and mutual respect in our nation of diversity**. To achieve this aim, the college gives utmost importance to the attribute of ‘**Discipline**’ and takes severe action on students who do not abide by the rules and regulations of the college. The college insists on following strict dress code. The college has been a haven of education for nearly **327 outstation students** and **9 overseas students**.

As the college has committed to provide **Quality Education** on par with the global standards, it has continually strived to improve its infrastructure facilities, educational practices, by improving the performance of staff and students. Hence, more members of the teaching community are encouraged to enroll for their research programmes and they are also motivated to present their research papers in the Seminars/ Conferences, and also to publish them. Students are given constant

support and special coaching to secure ranks in the University exams. As a result, last year, the college produced **39 Rank - holders** across different majors. See **ANNEXURE 1**.

## **21. Improvements in the library services**

The Central library plays a vital role in furthering the academic and research mission and facilitates creation and dissemination of knowledge. Besides holding an excellent print collection of over 17800 volumes of books, more than 2500 Back volumes and 200 Journals, theses and reports, it also provides access to over 80,000 electronic books, 2500 E-Journals and databases in Biosciences, Computer Technology, Social Sciences and management. The library has made a significant progress during the year.

- **Digital Library and N-List**

The Central Library has its own home page ([www.drngpaslibrary.pbworks.com](http://www.drngpaslibrary.pbworks.com)), and provides web-based access to its resources. It helps in procuring over 80,000 electronic books and 2500 E-Journals and Databases and supports on-line submission of theses and dissertations, and has set up an institutional repository of publications brought out by the Faculty community.

The Library maintains excellent rapport with **UGC Info Net-Digital Library Consortium (N-List)**. So, our staff and student community may use ILL services to obtain articles not owned by the central library.

- **E-Mail Alert**

A List of new additions of books and reports is issued every fortnight and can be accessed on the library home page. An **E-Mail alert** is also sent to all the faculty member(s) about the arrival of publications requested by them. Special care is taken to maintain the library stocks neatly to facilitate the users to locate the desired document quickly.

- **Library Services: Reference, Consultation & Circulation**

Circulation service helps users to make full use of library resources and services. It provides necessary assistance to users in locating information or document of their choice. The Library loaned **55969** books and other documents to its members during the year. In addition to members, **86499** visitors including students, research scholars and faculty members used the library. It is kept open from 8.00 AM to 8.00 PM on all working days and from 9.00AM to 5.00 PM hrs on Saturdays.

Library is also equipped with the latest editions of books for various competitive examinations. The Library also provides reprography and print out facility for students and staff members.

Library Entrance and Exit is done with the help of Bar-coding mechanism.

- The ICTACT and Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC) has been established with a vision of guiding ICT knowledge hub and skill-based training all the way through industry specific research thus cultivating a new generation of talent pool to contribute energetic, dynamic entrepreneurs for our mother nation.
- The ICTACT and Entrepreneurship Development Cell was established with the help of ICT Academy of Tamil Nadu, under its IIC (ICTACT Innovation and Incubation Centre) and Entrepreneurship Development Institute of Government of Tamil Nadu that facilitated the formation by funding Rs. 1 Lakh and will continue to focus on Entrepreneurship awareness, Training students and faculty on Innovation process and entrepreneurship, mentor innovations, create industry linkages and nurture entrepreneurship among colleges. ICT Academy with its existing partnerships with leading organizations including Microsoft, Intel, Autodesk, Oracle, IBM, Cognizant, TCS, Hexaware, Dell, Infosys etc., will work towards jointly nurturing innovation among students, thereby creating entrepreneurs from college.
- The cell has planned to organize various programmes collaboratively supported by Government of Tamil Nadu and Government of India. The cell also focuses on making research collaboration with ICT Academy of Tamil Nadu to build research culture among students and faculty community. So far, the cell has conducted two faculty development programmes with the intention of ‘Training the Trainers’.

## SECTION C
