#### **Goods & Service Tax**

The GST is basically an indirect tax that brings most of the taxes imposed on most goods and services, on manufacture, sale and consumption of goods and services, under a single domain at the national level. In the present system, taxes are levied separately on goods and services. The GST is a consolidated tax based on a uniform rate of tax fixed for both goods and services and it is payable at the final point of consumption. At each stage of sale or purchase in the supply chain, this tax is collected on value-added goods and services, through a tax credit mechanism.

## The proposed model of GST and the rate

A dual GST system is planned to be implemented in India as proposed by the Empowered Committee under which the GST will be divided into two parts:

- State Goods and Services Tax (SGST)
- Central Goods and Services Tax (CGST)

Both SGST and CGST will be levied on the taxable value of a transaction. All goods and services, leaving aside a few, will be brought into the GST and there will be no difference between goods and services. The GST system will combine Central excise duty, additional excise duty, services tax, State VAT entertainment tax etc. under one banner.

The GST rate is expected to be around 14-16 per cent. After the combined GST rate is fixed, the States and the Centre will decide on the SGST and CGST rates. At present, 10 per cent is levied on services and the indirect taxes on most goods is around 20 per cent.

#### **Advantages of GST Bill**

Introduction of a GST is very much essential in the emerging environment of the Indian economy.

 There is no doubt that in production and distribution of goods, services are increasingly used or consumed and vice versa. Separate taxes for goods and services, which is the present taxation system, requires division of transaction values into value of goods and services for taxation, leading to greater complications, administration, including compliances costs. In the GST system, when all the taxes are integrated, it would make possible the taxation burden to be split equitably between manufacturing and services.

- GST will be levied only at the final destination of consumption based on VAT principle and not at various points (from manufacturing to retail outlets). This will help in removing economic distortions and bring about development of a common national market.
- It will also help to build a transparent and corruption-free tax administration. Presently, a tax is levied on when a finished product moves out from a factory, which is paid by the manufacturer, and it is again levied at the retail outlet when sold.

### Challenges:

The bill is yet to be tabled and passed in the Parliament. To implement the bill there has to be lot changes at administration level, Information Technology integration has to happen, sound IT infrastructure is needed, the state governments has to be compensated for the loss of revenues and many more..GST, being a consumption-based tax, states with higher consumption of goods and services will have better revenues. So, the co-operation from state governments would be one of the key factors for the successful implementation of GST

Since GST replaces many cascading taxes, the common man may benefit after implementing it. But it all depends on 'what rate the GST is going to be fixed at?' Also, Small Traders may be exempted from it. France was the first country to introduce this system in 1954. Nearly 140 countries are following this tax system. GST could be the next biggest tax reform in India. This reform could be a continuing process until it is fully evolved. We need to wait few more months for more details on Goods & Services Tax system.

## **Interesting Facts about Accounting**

10 November is International Accounting Day and to mark this special event, we've put together some interesting facts about accountancy that may surprise you.

# 1. The father of accounting was Luca Pacioli

Italian mathematician Luca Pacioli published the first book about double-entry bookkeeping on 10 November 1494 - and it is in his honour that International Accountants Day was started. The book was called: Summa de Arithmetica, Geometria, Proportioni et Proportionalita, which translates as 'Everything About Arithmetic, Geometry and Proportion'

# 2. Ancient Egyptians had early auditing systems

Accounting is thousands of years old and can be traced as far back as ancient Mesopotamia. Early auditing systems have even been identified in ancient Egypt, while early forms of bookkeeping have been found in ancient Iran.

## 3. Many accounting terms have Latin roots

Accounting may be called 'the language of business', but did you know that many well known accounting terms are derived from Latin? The word 'debit' means 'he owes' in Latin, while 'credit' means 'he trusts'. The word 'accountant' is derived from the Latin 'computare', which means 'count'.

# 4. ICAS is the oldest professional body of chartered accountants in the world

ICAS was founded in 1854 by Royal Charter, making it the oldest professional body of chartered accountants. ICAS originated from the Edinburgh Society of Accountants, the Glasgow Institute of Accountants and Actuaries, and the Aberdeen Society of Accountants.

# 5. Oscar winning films featuring accountants

Accountants pop up in a number of Oscar-winning films, including Itzhak Stern (Ben Kingsley) in Schindler's List,

Oscar Wallace (Charles Martin Smith) in The Untouchables, Leo Bloom (Gene Wilder) in The Producers, and Bud Baxter (Jack Lemmon) in The Apartment. Other memorable movie accountants include Any Dufresne (Tim Robbins) in The Shawshank Redemption and of course, the loveable Louis Tully (Rick Moranis) in Ghostbusters.

# 6. Mick Jagger and Janet Jackson both studied accountancy

Mick Jagger of the Rolling Stones, Robert Plant of Led Zeppelin and singer Janet Jackson all studied accountancy - although Robert Plant abandoned his chartered accountancy training after just two weeks! Eddie Izzard also studied accountancy - while Scottish comedian Fred MacAulay worked as an accountant for a number of years.

## 7. The Romans were obsessed with accounting

The Roman army kept scrupulous records of cash, commodities and transactions, and they computed revenue every day. The public expenditure of Emperor Augustus was even documented and quantified for the Roman people.

US accountant Walter Diemer worked for the Fleer Corporation in the 1920s. But his big claim to fame is that he invented bubble gum in his spare time!

# 9. There is a patron saint of accountants

St Matthew of Apostle fame is the patron saint of accountants, bookkeepers and tax collectors. Before becoming an Apostle, he was a tax collector in the ancient town of Capernaum.

# 10. Ben Affleck will soon star as an accountant

Ben Affleck is set to play an accountant in a new thriller, aptly called 'The Accountant'. Affleck stars as a government accountant who moonlights as an assassin. The film is set to be released in late 2016.

## **National Company Law Appellate Tribunal**

It has been more than 14 years that we first heard about National Company Law Tribunal [NCLT] & National Company Law Appellate Tribunal [NCLAT]. But now by MCA Notification dated 1st June, 2016 in exercise of the powers conferred by section 408 of the Companies Act, 2013 (18 of 2013), the Central Government hereby constitutes the National Company Law Tribunal to exercise and discharge the powers and functions as are, or may be, conferred on it by or under the said Act with effect from the 1st day of June, 2016. The Companies (Second Amendment) Act, 2002 provides for the setting up of a National Company Law Tribunal and Appellate Tribunal to replace the existing Company Law Board and Board for Industrial and Financial Reconstruction. The setting up of NCLT as a specialized institution for corporate justice is based on the recommendations of the Justice Eradi Committee on Law Relating to Insolvency and Winding up of Companies.

## **Need of Specialized Courts or Tribunals:**

The genesis of setting up of specialized tribunals can be

traced to the Supreme Court judgment in Sampath Kumar case. In that case, while adopting the theory of alternative institutional mechanism for Supreme Court referred to the fact that since independence, the population explosion and the increase in litigation had greatly increased the burden of pendency in high courts. The supreme court also referred to studies conducted towards relieving the high court's of their increase load; the recommendations of the Shah committee for setting up independent tribunals as also the suggestion of the administrative reforms commission for setting up of Civil Service tribunals.

NCLT can be called as Mega Tribunal. Because NCLT will CONSOLIDATE the corporate jurisdiction of the followings:

- Company Law Board.
- The Board for Industrial and Financial Reconstruction
- The Appellate authority for Industrial and Financial Reconstruction
- Jurisdiction and powers relating to winding up restructuring and other such provisions, vested in the High courts
