AUTHOR GUIDELINES

- We invite articles from Social Work Practitioners, Industry Delegates, Academicians, Research scholars and Students irrespective of the disciplines.
- The article should be original and unpublished work of the author(s). The abstract of the paper should not exceed 150 words with 3-5 keywords.
- An electronic copy of the abstract should be sent on or before 10th Sep, 2024 to [m2k24ngp@gmail.com](mailto:mw2k24ngp@gmail.com)
- The first page of the manuscript should have title of the paper, name of the author, co-authors if any, affiliation, email address followed by abstract and full paper. The research paper should not exceed 6000 words, with Times New Roman Font, 12 font size and 1.5 line spacing. For empirical papers, the tables, charts and figures have to be placed on the respective places. Bibliography should be done by following APA style 7th Edition.
- The authors must register themselves by 12th Sep, 2024 to ensure the inclusion of article in the publication.
- All the selected papers will be published in the Peer-reviewed Indexed Journal.
- Publication fee will be intimated later.
- Best papers will be selected from each session and rewarded during the valedictory function.
